- **Teams API Response Header Location Custom change**

What we do: Created shared flow to include custom change to update Location Header with Apigee host and basepath instead of backend host.

Benefit: Prevented unnecessary exposure of backend URLs to the consumers.

- **CORS KVM anywhere URL update**

What we do: Updating CORS KVM entries with developers.anywhere.re along with developers.reality.com. Getting ready for next week anywhere branding changes.

Benefit: Consumers branding changes are supported by whitelisting anywhere.re URLs.

- **Bug Fix – App Questionnaire Validation.**

What we did: Fix the app questionnaire validation failed scenario bug.

Benefits: This will give user to create the app through the app questionnaire form without any issue.

- **Pipeline to support YAML deployments**

What we did: We are now supporting the YAML specification in addition to JSON.

Benefits: Publisher can process both YAML and JSON specification.

- **Pipeline to support the new basepath format**

What we did: Updated pipeline script to support both the basepath format based on the custom field.

Benefits: By including the custom field in the specification, the publisher can change to the new basepath format.
